Beyond Boundaries Scholarship update-Holli Gardner

- We do not know who the recipient is yet, but it may not have been awarded since the funds were collected during the 2023 year
- The recipient may not be awarded until 2024-2025 year

A/P Faculty Professional Development Leave Working Group-Susan Short

- Presentation slide
- There is an educational leave policy already in place that AP faculty are allowed to utilize
- That wording was removed from the Professional Development Leave proposal
- Surveys determined that an appropriate time for the use of leave to be 1-3 months
- Full pay will be offered in the proposal
- The group intends to have a draft for review for the AP faculty senate September meeting
- The group understands that inequities could be created since some units have better ability to cover the PD leave periods than others

- Conversations will be started with colleges and units so that it will not be a surprise to them and they can plan for implementation when the time comes
- Is there any requirement of expectations of the faculty member that utilizes the leave and what happens when they return? Should there be language about requirements about staying in the current position for a certain period of time or consequences if they leave that position? Yes-there is language in other MOUs that the group is using as a model
- Please include extension agents in the group discussions. Perhaps have an example of how an extension agent might use the policy
- 5 years of service is the current timeline for being able to utilize the leave; perhaps language about extension agent reaching that official rank before utilizing the leave
- Please make sure there is a strong application and selection process in place
- In addition, language that not everyone will be approved for the leave should be very clear
