- Task Force convened by President Sands at the request of the Board of Visitors
- Provost Clark and Robert Weiss are sponsors of the task force
- Robin Queen will chair the task force
- First meetings have been completed and task force members are reviewing a plethora of information
- Information will come to the AP Faculty senate when it is ready
- Goal is to have a statement created by the end of fall 2022

Job Architecture Update-by Evans Lusuli

- Congratulations to the faculty award winners!
- This project is very complex which is why it has not previously been completed
- Goal is to complete by fall 2022 so that it can be evaluated in spring 2023
- The project is currently broken down into 3 stages
 - Stage 1 (Pilot Phase)

- A framework has been developed and work has moved forward with the groups that are involved (Information Technology is a primary group)
- Stage 2
 - 50-60% completed
 - August 18 deadline and August 21 for feedback from stakeholders
- Stage 3
 - Continued evaluation of job functions

Philanthropic Project Selection

- Advancement is willing to work with us to collect funds so the project should be connected to Virginia Tech
- The Marketplace or The Employee Student Scholarship fund and the VT rescue squad would all be good examples
- \$10 per AP faculty member could raise \$20,000 towards a cause and make a huge impact
- This would be a great idea and a way for our new AP faculty to make an impact
- Holli proposes a vote to approve choosing a cause: 24 agree
- Options: a cause connected to faculty "leave", student food insecurity, the Marketplace, the Student Emergency Fund, Little Hokie Hangout, child care resources
- It is important to make sure that the need we choose is not something that is already well funded
- Can we also be sure that we appeal to a cause that off campus AP faculty could support as well?
- Please send additional thoughts on causes to Holli
- We will complete research on the causes and bring it back to the AP faculty senate for continued discussion

CAPFA Updates-Janice Austin

 - Shared folders will be updated based on new access

Other Topics or Business

- Constituents Working Group
 - Constitution update recommendation: move from 30 to 31 voting senators to allow for one additional Library senator
 - Updates to constituent working groups (see google doc)
 - <u>Constituent determination tool</u> created so AP faculty could better understand where they fall within the working groups
 - Draft determination tool available and updates can be made before publishing
 - Group choose not to make significant changes until the job architecture update is complete; from the job architecture categories could
 - Approximately 50-70 employees should be part of each group within the job architecture
 - After the initial updates are made, 5 year evaluation should be completed
 - Does the addition of one member change how we rotate senators on and off the AP faculty senate? AP faculty senate will need to discuss that when the time comes
 - Use the new designation tool and provide feedback!
